The City of Virginia Beach offers many resources when it comes to cyber security. On the Virginia Beach official website you can find information regarding safety when on the internet and how to protect yourself and others from harm such as "identity theft" and "managing your online reputation". Virginia Beach has a web page dedicated to practicing safe technology use and you can find it by going to the "Public Safety" tab on their website under "Practice Safe Cyber".
